LatAm's most dangerous countries for business

Venezuela, Honduras and Guatemala were rated as the most dangerous countries in Latin America for the business community, according to a report by consulting firm FTI.

The three countries received the highest "danger level" (5), along with a "red" outlook - meaning a trend toward an even higher danger level - in the firm's regional security index.

Venezuela's "corruption, organized crime and violent political clashes have worsened an already critical situation," the report said.

Mexico was given a danger level of five with a yellow, or stable, outlook. Chile and Panama, meanwhile, were rated as the safest countries
